Eddie Adams (June 12, 1933 – September 18, 2004) was an American photographer and photojournalist noted for portraits of celebrities and politicians and for coverage of 13 wars. He won a Pulitzer Prize in 1969.

The majority of Mount Saint Peter Church and rectory were built from the Mellon mansion, including the red Michigan sandstone, angel statues, marble, granite, bronze doors, railings, 30 tons of steel beams, 65 oak doors, and chandeliers. The current church ceiling tiles (300 in all) were cast from original 24 carrot gold ceiling from the mansion. Mount Saint Peter opened in 1944.
