The challenge locations and times are on your map and the times during which you can complete them are listed below.


All-Oakland Clues



Take a picture of each of the following

- 1. A porch with at least one couch on it (we're talking real couches, not patio furniture, not lawn furniture, nothing like that. These are couches that in most other neighborhoods would be exclusively indoors)
- 2. What must be a violation of building code (but where there's no building permit in sight).
- 3. A pair of shoes dangling from wires overhead.
- 4. Even as the weather gets colder, some Pittsburghers are willing to brave the temperatures to enjoy the outdoors. Catch someone (not on Urban Hike!) running, biking or studying outside.
